



Instructions

Instead of sticking the motifs behind the window and tracing them directly onto the window glass, you can also conveniently transfer the pictures to window film at the table and then bring them to the window. You can reuse the images as often as you like.

Clearly defined motifs with clear contours that can be easily cut out are suitable for this technique. Filigree motifs with frayed edges are not so good, as tracing them directly onto the window pane produces better results.

THAT'S HOW IT'S DONE

① Download and print out the template. If a large motif is divided into several pages, match the parts to the mark glue together. Window films are available in several sizes.

② **Important:** First, remove any impregnations and grease backing from the window film. Free the markers (including finger taps) so that the markers work well later and stick evenly and does not roll off in some places. To do this, wipe the film with a damp sponge and a little dishwash liquid wipe thoroughly. Better wipe once more, than once too little. Let dry.

③ Place the template on the window film and the film is best already once roughly cut to the shape of the template, then it can be done handle it better. Remove the foil from the backing paper and place it over the template. Fix with paper clips or small clothespins so that nothing slips.

For small motifs, you can also cut out the paper template and clamp it between the backing paper and the foil, i. H. the slide is not complete pull off, just lift off a piece and slide the template in between. This also prevents anything from slipping. But that really only works Good for smaller, handy sheets, larger foils curl up.

④ Trace the motif onto the window film with multi-markers and color in. Likes to work with different layers of paint and paint on details with mini multi-markers. Bright colors and neon markers work particularly well, as they really shine when the light falls on the window. Allow each layer of paint to dry before painting a new color over it.

- ⑤ Let everything dry well. If necessary, cut out the motif again and "stick" it to the window. Gluing is actually not the right term as it statically cling without glue. You know the motive can be removed at any time without leaving any residue - and reused later.

Tip: The backing paper on which the window film is supplied definitely cancel. You can carefully remove the window picture as a whole peel off the window and put it back on the backing paper, roll up and store in this way to save space until you make you want to stick it on your window again. 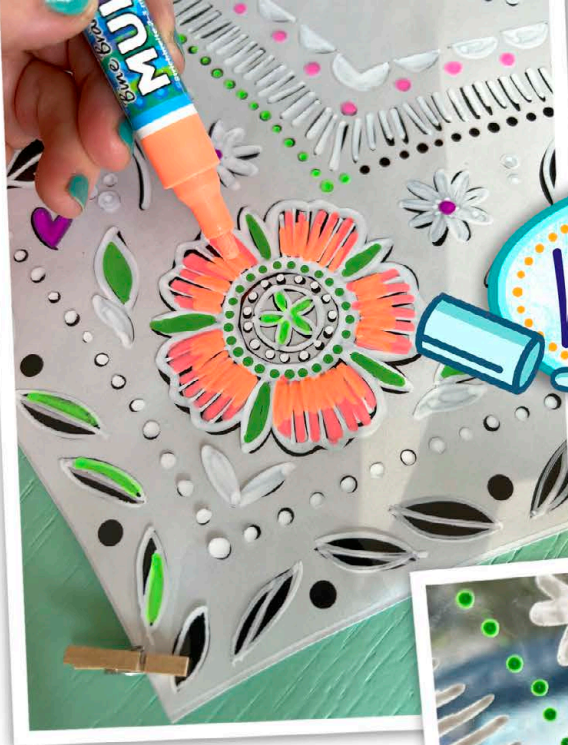
